Profile of the Speaker:



Christine Haight Farley is a Professor of Law at American University Washington College of Law. She teaches courses on Intellectual Property Law, Trademark Law, International and Comparative Trademark Law, International Intellectual Property Law, Design Protection Law and Art Law. Professor Farley served as Associate Dean for Faculty and Academic Affairs from 2007 to 2011 and as Co-Director of the Program on Information Justice and Intellectual Property from 2005 to 2009. She has also taught International Intellectual Property Law at University of Paris West, Art Law at University of Puerto Rico, and International Trademark Law at Monash University as a visiting professor. Prior to teaching, Professor Farley was an associate specializing in intellectual property litigation with Rabinowitz, Boudin, Standard, Krinsky & Lieberman in New York. She received a B.A. from Binghamton University, a J.D. from University at Buffalo Law School, and an LL.M. and J.S.D. from Columbia Law School. Professor Farley's scholarly work is in the areas of on intellectual property, international law and art law.
