and

**TELANGANA STATE COUNCIL OF HIGHER EDUCATION**

### **Indo-American Chamber of Commerce**

The Indo-American Chamber of Commerce (IACC), established in 1968, is the apex bi-lateral Chamber synergizing India-US Economic Engagement. It acts as a catalyst for sustainable growth of business between India and the US. IACC promotes bilateral trade, investment and technology transfer, facilitates business collaborations, joint ventures, marketing tie-ups and strategic alliances through a set of proactive business-oriented initiatives. The chamber had organized several business programs having high social impact in the Education, Aviation & Aerospace, Energy, Infrastructure and other Industry sector.

### **Telangana State Council of Higher Education (TSCHE)**

Telangana State Council of Higher Education was constituted as State Council on August 5' 2014. Telangana State Council of Higher Education is a Statutory Body of Government of Telangana which is responsible for coordination and planning of Higher Education.

### **Objective**

- Promote cooperation and coordination of the Educational Institutions among themselves and explore the scope for interaction with industry and other related

establishments and to encourage and promote innovations in curriculum development, restructuring of Courses and updating of syllabi in the University and the Colleges

**The two Institutions herewith agree to:**

- a) Conduct Seminars, Conferences, Workshops etc to disseminate information about Higher Education opportunities in India and US.
- b) Provide guidance regarding career opportunities and options for visiting students from India and US.
- c) Work with Universities and other higher educational institutions in India and US for exchange of knowledge and skills.
- d) Cooperate in exchanging of information relating to activities in teaching and research in fields of mutual interests.
- e) Promote appropriate joint research projects with particular emphasis on internationally funded projects.
- f) Assist student and faculty visits to promote short term industry programs/ internships.
- g) Foster innovation, incubation and encourage entrepreneurship to improve the overall skills of students in India and US .

The above MoU shall be valid for a period of 2 years form the **date of entering the MoU.**
