This Memorandum of understanding sets forth the terms and conditions between

- Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (MPCB) with the registered address at Kalpataru Point, 3rd and 4th floor, Opp. PVR Theatre, Sion (E), Mumbai-400022
- Datamatics Global Services Ltd with the registered address at Unit 701, Tower 2, Link Road, SEEPZ, Andheri East, Mumbai, Maharashtra 400096
- Indo-American Chamber of Commerce (IACC) with registered address at 1-C, Vulcan Insurance Building, Veer Nariman Road, Churchgate, Mumbai 400020

Hereafter referred to as "parties", hereby confirm their intent to make common cause, bilateral relations as mentioned below:

1. PREAMBLE

This MoU is regarding the collaboration between MPCB, DATAMATICS GLOBAL SERVICES LTD. and IACC towards creating interactions and exchange opportunities in the domain of technology, innovation and trade related to Environment, Pollution control and health impact through engagement between both organizations.

The suggested areas of collaboration (not limited to) are listed below

- Share knowledge, experiences and best practices through, for example, technology transfer and expert exchanges
- Train and improve the skills of staff members
- Help accelerate and scale up MPCB efforts to share and use pollution related data (for example the star-rating program)
- Conduct research and organize events publicizing the health impacts of pollution and mitigation measures
- Periodical exchange of dialogues between the three parties on Environmental goals







2. SCOPE OF MOU

The parties under the MOU will jointly work towards creating a schedule of interactions and exchange opportunities in the domain of technology, innovation and trade related to Environment, Pollution control and Sustainability

3. CONFIDENTIALITY:

The Parties, to the extent of their respective rights to do so, shall exchange such technical information and data as is reasonably required of each Party to perform its responsibilities under this MoU. Each Party agrees to keep in confidence and to use the same degree of care as it uses with respect to its own proprietary data to prevent the disclosure to third Parties of all technical information, data and confidential business information (hereinafter referred to as "Consolidated Data").

- Exchange, use and maintenance of Confidential Data shall be mutually discussed and agreed to by the parties.
- The preceding provisions of confidentiality and restriction on use of Consolidated Data shall not apply to:
- Information in the public domain or information, which subsequently enter into public domain without committing breach of this Article.
- Information in possession of the Party at the time of disclosure and was not acquired, directly or indirectly, from the other Party.
- Information, which a Party requires to disclose under law, rules or regulations or court orders.

4. DURATION AND COMMENCEMENT OF MOU

- This MOU shall be effective from the date of signing.
- The duration of the MOU shall be for a period of Five (5) years from the effective date
- During its tenancy the MOU may be extended or terminated by a prior notice of not less than Three (3) months by either of the three parties.
