Patti Hoffman, US consul general in Calcutta, addresses members of the Indo-American Chamber of Commerce (IACC) and industry stakeholders at The Alcor Hotel in Bistupur, Jamshedpur, on Monday evening. Hoffman, who took charge in August 2018, said the US is India's largest and most important trading partner and one of its largest investors. Hoffman will visit Tata Motors, and American firms Timken Company and Cummins as part of her two-day steel city visit. She announced that the US-India Education Foundation would soon start a start a nine-month course in Jamshedpur for developing English-speaking skills of local students. She urged American companies operating here to include the anti-human-trafficking programmes in their corporate social responsibility initiatives. Chairman of Ramkrishna Forgings Limited M.P.
