GUIDELINES FOR COMPLETING THE NOMINATION FORM

- The form should be filed in English only.
- ▶ The font type & size to be used is Trebuchet MS 11
- Incomplete or hand-written forms will not be accepted for evaluation.
- Please restrict your responses in the space provided for each section. Additional page(s) may not be evaluated.
- A participating organization may choose to nominate themselves in more than one award category. However, a participant may not nominate themselves for both Excellence in Manufacturing and Excellence in Services categories.
- Participants may provide documents / brochures / layouts / photographs to support their responses. Such supporting documents may be referred to by the jury during evaluation. Please restrict the file size to 10 MB for all supporting documents that are accompanied with a nomination form.
- Reference to supporting documents must be provided against the respective questions in the space provided. If a supporting document is provided, then the reference box should be ticked. Supporting documents should be named as follows Company name_Award category_Question number. (e.g., for IACC CSR Award, Question 1 will be IACC_CSR_Q1).
- Responses for all questions, unless specified, are expected to pertain to Financial Year 2022-23 only.
- Please restrict your responses for every question to 350 words, except expressed otherwise.

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING THE NOMINATION FORM

- The nomination form must be submitted by an authorized representative of the company along with their digital signature, using the company's official e-mail ID.
- The nomination form must be submitted in an editable PDF file format as received by the participant. Refrain from sending a scanned copy of the nomination form to ensure responses are not truncated.
- > The nomination form will be considered final, accurate and best to the knowledge of the respondent.

GUIDELINES FOR ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Companies participating under the category for 'INDIAN COMPANIES' must be a company registered in India or must either be a subsidiary or under the management and control of a company registered in India as on 31 March 2023 and should have operated in the US for a minimum of two years (i.e., since before 1 April 2021).
- Companies participating under the category for 'US COMPANIES' must be a company registered in United States of America (USA) or must either be a subsidiary or under the management and control of a company registered in the USA as on 31 December 2022 and have operated in India for a minimum of two years (i.e., since before 1 January 2021).
- All participating companies must be in operation at the time of filing their nominations.
- With respect to companies participating under the 'Industry Excellence Award' category, the threshold limit for annual turnover for eligibility of category 1 is up to INR 10,000 Cr or USD 1.5 billion and for eligibility of category 2 is more than INR 10,000 Cr or USD 1.5 billion.
- Business groups, holding companies and conglomerates may not nominate themselves as a single entity. Entities within larger group companies should apply individually. There is no limit on the number of entities that may apply from a single group.
- Previous edition award winners may apply only if the nominated initiatives in Industry Excellence Award Category vary from the ones submitted in the previous editions.

It is mandatory to attach the digital signature of the authorized personnel from the applying company on the last page of this nomination form.





GUIDELINES FOR DISCLAIMERS

- All information submitted as part of the award will be kept confidential and will only be used for the jury's assessment.
- The jury has the right to reclassify application forms from one award category to another, from a fitment and category definition perspective.
- Each submission will be pre-screened using the same eligibility and selection criteria that will be used in the final judging. All applications will be evaluated by eminent jury members to determine the finalists.
- The finalists will be notified prior to the event. They will be required to maintain the confidentiality of the results until the official announcement of the winner at the event, slated to be held on 22 September 2023.
- Efforts will be made to adhere to the defined timelines. However, the timelines are subject to change, based on circumstances.
