PRESS RELEASE 1: 'India- US Climate Change Mitigation to Help Create Well-Paying Green Jobs'- Mr. Jorgen K. Andrews

New Delhi, September 24, 2024: The strides jointly made by India and the US in terms of climate change mitigation and energy transition not only lead to a better planet but also create the much anticipated green jobs, said the Deputy Chief of Mission of the US Embassy Mr. Jorgen K. Andrews in New Delhi.

Addressing the 21st Indo-US Economic Summit organized by the Indo-American Chamber of Commerce (IACC) on Tuesday, the top US Embassy official noted that the India-US relationship is getting deeper and wider from all aspects. Highlighting the need to curb climate change, he said that if not resolved, climate change would have a significant impact on the collective prosperity of both the countries.

The theme of the 21st economic summit held in the national capital is 'Building Bridges, Shaping Futures: Pioneering Pathways for 21st Century Growth'.

"The impact on our collective prosperity if we do not solve these climate change problems together is profound. Together, I think we are doing some amazing things both at the government level and in private sector to reduce emissions to help India find a path for growth and development that does not overly exacerbate global climatic challenges and also, these changes would create the well-paying green jobs that I know we would all like to see," said Mr. **Jorgen K. Andrews, Deputy Chief of Mission of the US Embassy.**

Observing the fast pace of growth in bilateral ties, he said that the strengthening and robust ties have provided "tremendous benefit" for people in both the countries.

The statement comes close on the heels of the bilateral talks between Prime Minister Narendra Modi and US President Joe Biden last week in the US on the sidelines of the QUAD Summit.

Mr Andrews further informed that the India-US Commercial Dialogue and the CEOs forum would be held next week in the US with the Union Minister for Commerce and Industry Mr Piyush Goyal and the US Secretary of Commerce Gina Raimondo co-chairing the meetings.

"Next week the Minister of Commerce and Industry Goyal will be in Washington and he'll have a chance to meet with his counterpart Secretary of Commerce Gina Raimondo. Together they will co-chair the US, India commercial dialogue, and CEO forum. This is another one of these crucial links between government and industry that helps us build-out," he said.

Speaking at the inaugural session of the summit, **Dr. Abhay Sinha, Director General, the Services Export Promotion Council** said that trade with the US comprises a significant portion of India's overall services exports worth about \$350 billion.

He was of the view that efforts should be made to develop synergy and create opportunities in services and manufacturing sectors in the US market for Indian businesses.

Dr. Lalit Bhasin, Summit Chair & Immediate Past National President, Indo-American Chamber of Commerce cited the latest round of agreements between both the countries last week said that the robust bilateral cooperation and mutual support can be gauged from the media reports on the number of pacts signed between both the countries, which ensure a continued strengthening of the ties.

"Whosoever wins the November (US) election, the Indo-US election will continue to grow stronger and stronger," Dr Bhasin said.

Mr. Awanish Kumar Awasthi, IAS (Retd), Advisor to the Chief Minister, Government of Uttar Pradesh noted that the state provides one of the best business environments in the country with a robust implementation of the rule of law. Inviting global investors to Uttar Pradesh, Mr. Awasthi said that it is one of the most investor-friendly states with a clear and attractive foreign direct investment (FDI) policy.

PRESS RELEASE 2: Public-Private Partnerships Need to Ensure Affordable and Quality

New Delhi, September 24, 2024: With the growing healthcare market in the country, the coming together of public and private sector should ensure availability and affordability along with access to quality of healthcare, said **Mr. Madhukar Kumar Bhagat, Joint Secretary, Union Ministry of Health And Family Government of India**

Speaking at the 21st Indo-US Economic Summit organized by the Indo-American Chamber of Commerce (IACC) Mr Bhagat noted that while the private sector largely takes into account the commercial side of a sector, in the case of healthcare, it needs to move beyond commercial interest. He also said that in regions where the private sector would not foray for healthcare services, the government would pitch in.

"We have to talk about a partnership between the government and private sector to bring about these four fundamental things, availability of healthcare, affordability of healthcare, access to healthcare and quality of healthcare," he said, adding that the whole vision of 'Vikshit Bharat' (Developed India) has to be people centric.

Talking of the government's efforts to boost healthcare services in the country, he also said that the Union Government is focussing on technological advancement through Artificial Intelligence (AI) apart from taking healthcare to the interior regions of the country.

"If I talk from the economic perspective, then the areas of market failure have to be taken into account by the government. If I talk about the rural area I cannot think that immediately in the near future I can see corporate hospitals operating over there and therefore that is a region of market failure where the government has to have its presence," the top official said. He also stressed on the role of the government in terms of regulating the healthcare space by laying standards, and roadmaps and overseeing practices are ethical in this important sector for the country.

"At the same time there is also expectation from the government that it is going to aid in cutting-edge research, which the government is doing in the field of AI," Mr Bhagat said.

Speaking at the event themed 'Building Bridges, Shaping Futures: Pioneering Pathways for 21st Century Growth', **Ms. Genessa Giorgi, Health Attaché at the US Embassy** in New Delhi, emphasized on the need for a global push for healthcare going beyond the boundaries of India and the US.

"By prioritizing healthcare, investing in innovation and fostering partnership we can create a prosperous, equitable and healthy society. Not just India, US but for the whole globe," she said.

PRESS RELEASE 3: Uttar Pradesh to Set Up Semiconductor Plant Soon: Shri Jitin Prasada

New Delhi, September 24, 2024: In yet another move to boost economic growth, Uttar Pradesh is all set to get a semiconductor manufacturing unit, said Shri **Jitin Prasada, Minister of State for Commerce & Industry, Government of India.**

Addressing the 21st Indo-US Economic Summit organized by the Indo-American Chamber of Commerce (IACC), the minister said that India is a major investment destination across sector including semiconductors and within the country Uttar Pradesh is among the top states and would turn out to be the "growth engine of India" going ahead.

"We will start work on a semiconductor plant in Uttar Pradesh also. I am very confident that the state will be among the few places to have such niche facilities," Prasada said, while describing the development as ground-breaking.

The statement gains significance as it comes just days after India and the US tied up to set up a semiconductor fabrication plant in the country.

"The Prime Minister recently signed an MoU for chip manufacturing with the US. The focus is that these technologies will be more and more visible in the day-to-day life of people going ahead and it's necessary that we understand these technologies at the earliest," he said, adding that semiconductors are key to India's digital transformation goals.

He also emphasized on the government's focus of taking the benefit of technology to the length and breadth of the country and to the interior and rural areas.

Noting that convergence and partnership are key for the growth of semiconductor development, Mr Prasada said: "The India-US partnership will have far reaching impact."

Speaking on the partnership between both the countries, he said that apart from semiconductors and Artificial Intelligence (AI), will explore innovations, capacity building.

He also said that regulatory environment, he stressed on flow of data between countries and adequate and robust cyber security ecosystem. The state minister for commerce & industry said that cyber security is the need of the hour given the divergence of warfare from physical attacks to cyberspace.

On the macroeconomic growth of India, the minister said the growth trajectory of India is resilient with the fundamentals being sound and strong.

"India is marching ahead towards its goal with great pace," he said.

On the Indo-US bilateral ties, Mr Prasada said that the partnership has now turned equal with both the countries mutually benefitting from the partnership. He said that India would also be able to impart skill and knowledge to people from the US under the partnership going ahead.

PRESS RELEASE 4: Businesses in India and US need to come together for robust ESG ecosystem: US Embassy Official

New Delhi, September 24, 2024: With the countries and companies setting ambitious net zero goals and emphasis issues like gender equality growing, private sector in India and the US need to come together to have a robust Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) ecosystem, **Mr. Damon DuBord**, Chief of Energy Affairs at U.S. Embassy in New Delhi.

Speaking at the 21st Indo-US Economic Summit organized by the Indo-American Chamber of Commerce (IACC) on Tuesday, Mr DuBord said that the US government is implementing strong ESG norms for corporates through the 21st Indo-US Economic Summit organized by the Indo-American Chamber of Commerce (IACC) on Tuesday. He noted that both in India and the US companies ranging from small businesses to large corporates are focussed on ESG norms and their adequate implementation.

"It's really through partnership, because many of these measures are voluntary. We need to see companies in the U.S and Indian multinationals coming forward, putting their best foot forward to show both their environmental, their social, and their governance strategies to tackle these important issues," he said.

Responding to a question on whether focus should be more critical mineral mining or recycling of batteries for these minerals, he said that both the aspects are key for ESG requirements and energy security.

Speaking at the panel discussion on 'Environmental, Social, and Governance (Climate Change)', **Mr. Jeevaraj G. Pillai, Whole Time Director, Director - Sustainability, President - Flexible Packaging and New Product Development, Uflex Ltd** stressed on the need to educate people in the supply chain including vendors on mitigating carbon emission, circular economy and waste management.

"It's very important that a carbon mitigation plan is in place," Mr Pillai said.

In a presentation during the session, **Mr. Sunil Jain, Chairman, Energy Committee, IACC & Founder Partner, Sundev Renewables LLP** said highlighted the gravity of the situation in terms of economic inequality and adverse climate

events and said that in the wake of growing disparity between the rich and the poor, and rising instances of corporate governance failure, the need for ESG measure has become all the more important.

"Governments and corporations have realized that aspirations of the populations are growing rapidly but running a business means having to be on the 'right side of the planet'," he said.

Dr Manish Kumar Shrivastava, Associate Director, Earth Science and Climate Change at the The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI) said that there is a need to understand the various aspects of the ESG measures and should have the required multilateral approach.

"The path forward is going to have that scientific understanding of overlaps both in institutional responses and institutional mechanism.. Scientific understanding of where are the overlaps, what are the commonalities, and which are the low hanging fruits and integrating them in the various levels of governance structure is very important," said Dr Shrivastava.

Outlining the progress in India on the ESG front, **Sudhir Mishra, Founder & Managing Director Trust Legal (Advocates & Consultants)** said that in the past few years significant progress has been made and going ahead with many manufacturing hubs coming up globally, India will have to be ready to compete with newer competitors like Vietnam and Cambodia and show to the world the progress it has made on this front.

PRESS RELEASE 5: 'Need Lower Tariffs, Harmonisation of Norms to Boost Indo-US Agri Trade'

New Delhi, September 24, 2024: As the India-US bilateral relations grow with the consistent growth in trade between the two countries, there is a need for lower tariffs and harmonization of local norms in order to boost agriculture trade between two of the major global economies, said **industry leaders at the 21st Indo-US Economic Summit organized by the Indo-American Chamber of Commerce (IACC)**.

Addressing the programme, **Mr. Sanjeev Bisht, Vice President – Value Added Products, Agri Business Division, ITC Ltd** noted that the recent supply chain disruptions due to the Red Sea crisis, the absence of a free trade agreement (FTA) between the two countries and local quality norms are among the key concern areas in the bilateral agriculture trade space.

"Quality norms are a critical part. If we want to increase exports, we need to understand the quality concerns of that country, how the norms can be worked out in terms of harmonization of standards in India. Our export is only 10-20%, domestic consumption is 80%. How the standards become common that needs to be worked upon," he said.

Noting that policy framework is a key aspect, Mr Bisht said that sustainability and technology are important aspects that need to be emphasised upon to increase productivity with reduction in ecological impact.

"We have a lot of innovation happening in AI. If we can combine them together, there is scope," he said. In a presentation during the session on agriculture and food processing, Mr. Bisht noted that resilient seed varieties and AI-based weather and climate prediction systems are required along with lowering of tariffs.

Mr. Chirag Jain, Partner, Grant Thornton Bharat pointed out that the US comprises 10% of India's agriculture exports, supplies of India only account for 2.6% of the farm imports taken up by the US, leaving enough potential for India to boost its exports to the world's largest economy.

In a bid to boost ties in the agriculture space, Mr. Jain recommended ease in technology transfer, implementation of successful research & development

models (R&D), capacity building in climate-smart agriculture, enhancement of trade for fresh produce and greater private sector participation among others.

"India offers a growing market for US exports while US innovations can help India improve its agricultural productivity," he said. Talking on the issue of tariffs, Mr. Jain further said that both the countries need to develop tariff models to avoid global supply chain disruptions and benefiting farmers from both countries.

He also called for continued engagement between the two countries at trade forums, strategic trade dialogues and World Trade Organization.

The other speakers in the session themed 'Vision for the Future of Indo-US Economic Relations in Agro & Food Processing' included Mr. Jasmohan Singh, Chairman, Agro & Food Processing Comm. IACC & Managing Director, Frick India Ltd and Mr. Ravinkumar Sivalingam, Sustainable Agriculture Strategy, Digital Food Initiatives Tata Consultancy Services.

The strides jointly made by India and the US in terms of climate change mitigation and energy transition will not only lead to a better planet but also create green jobs, said Jorgan Andrews, deputy chief of mission of the US embassy in New Delhi, on Tuesday.

India says it is poised to create 30 million green jobs by 2050, marking a significant shift towards sustainability and environmental responsibility in the job market.

In July, both countries renewed their commitment to a US-India Strategic Clean Energy Partnership (SCEP) to strengthen energy security, create opportunities for clean energy innovation, address climate change and create employment opportunities.
