GUIDELINES FOR COMPLETING THE NOMINATION FORM

- The form should be completed in English only.
- ▶ The font type and size to be used is Trebuchet MS 11
- Incomplete or hand-written forms will not be accepted for evaluation.
- ▶ Please limit your responses to the space provided for each section. Additional page(s) may not be evaluated.
- A participating organisation may choose to nominate itself in more than one award category. However, a participant may not nominate themselves in both the Excellence in Manufacturing and Excellence in Services categories.
- Participants may provide documents/ brochures/ layouts/ photographs to support their responses. Such supporting documents may be referenced by the applicant for the ease of evaluation. Please limit the file size to a maximum of 10 MB for all supporting documents that are accompanied by a nomination form.
- ▶ Reference to supporting documents must be provided against the respective questions in the space provided. If a supporting document is provided, then the reference box should be ticked. Supporting documents file should be named as follows Company name_Award category Question number. (e.g., for the IACC Service Award, Question 1 will be IACC_Service_Q1).
- Responses for all questions, unless specified, are expected to pertain to FY 2024-25 only.
- Please limit your responses to 350 words per question, unless stated otherwise.





GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING THE NOMINATION FORM

- The nomination form must be submitted by an authorised representative of the company along with their digital signature, using the company's official e-mail ID.
- ▶ The nomination form should be submitted in an editable PDF file format as received by the participant. Refrain from sending a scanned copy of the nomination form to ensure responses are not truncated.
- ▶ The nomination form will be considered final, accurate and best to the knowledge of the respondent.

GUIDELINES FOR ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Companies participating in the category of 'INDIAN COMPANIES IN US' must be registered in India or a subsidiary of Indian Companies in US or under the management and control of a company registered in India as of 31 March 2025 and should have had office(s) in the US for a minimum of two years (i.e., since before 1 April 2023).
- Companies participating in the category for 'US COMPANIES IN INDIA' must be a company registered in the United States of America (USA) or a subsidiary of US company in India or under the management and control of a company registered in the USA as of 31 December 2024 and have had office(s) in India for a minimum of two years (i.e., since before 1 January 2023).
- All participating companies must be in operation at the time of filing their nominations.
- Business groups, holding companies and conglomerates may not nominate themselves as a group entity. Entities within larger group companies should apply individually. There is no limit on the number of entities that may apply from a group.
- Companies participating under the category 'MSME Top Exporter' must share MSME registration certificate.

It is mandatory to attach the digital signature of the authorised personnel from the applying company on the last page of this nomination form.





DISCLAIMERS

- All information submitted as part of the award will be kept confidential and will only be used by the process partner for processing information for the jury.
- ► The jury has the right to reclassify application forms from one award category to another, based on the fitment and category definition.
- Each submission will be pre-screened using the same eligibility and selection criteria that will be applied in the final judging. All applications will be evaluated by eminent jury members to determine the finalists.
- Finalists will be notified prior to the event. They will be required to maintain the confidentiality of the results until the official announcement of the winner at the event, scheduled for 19 September 2025.
- While efforts will be made to adhere to the defined timelines, these are subject to change based on circumstances.
- Directors/Key Management Personnel should come to receive the award.
