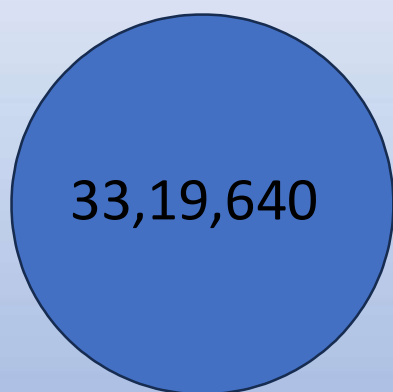

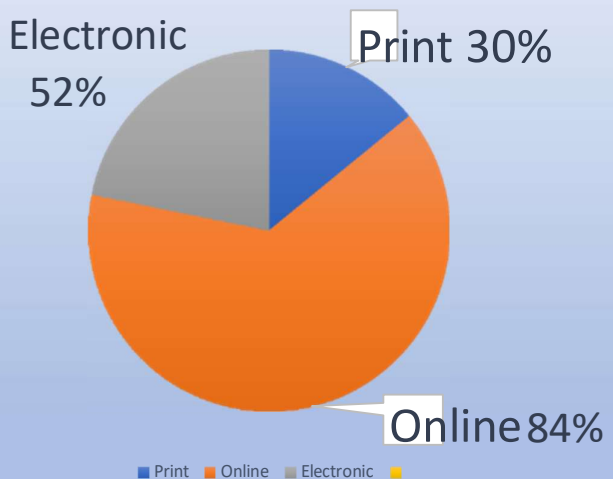

# Good news on India-US trade deal once it is fair, says Goyal

## 'Need To Protect Stakeholders Like Farmers, Fishermen'

**New Delhi:** Commerce and industry minister Piyush Goyal Tuesday said there was "no hiatus" in the Indo-US relationship and that "you will hear good news" on a trade deal once it is fair, equitable, and balanced.

Goyal described the bilateral partnerships as "very important and very strategic" and said negotiations were a process that should protect India's stakeholders like farmers, fishermen, small industry, and workers. "When we find the right balance, you can rest assured we will get outcomes," he said.

The minister pointed to recent steps, such as the 10-year defence pact signed between the two nations as well as the LPG supply agreement for about 2.2 million tonnes per annum, arguing that they are for the long-term. "We both are equally committed to expanding tra-

de and commerce," he added.

He also spoke of efforts to help the fisheries and marine sector after the US tariffs have hit it especially hard. He added that Russia is on course to approve nearly 25 fishery establishments and talks are underway with countries, such as the UAE to diversify India's shrimp and fish exports. The European Union (EU) too has approved 102 additional marine product units from India for exports.

Goyal also said that govt

was ready with the third edition of the Jan Vishwas bill to ease doing business in the country. He said the govt prepared the bill with the aim of "decriminalising all the provisions of law wherever we can make life easier for businesses and the community".

In last session of Parliament, govt had introduced Jan Vishwas-II and the commerce and industry ministry had begun talks to include more provisions. The minister's comments indicated that a fresh bill may be introduced.

New Delhi: Commerce and industry minister Piyush Goyal said on Tuesday that the "good news" on the India-US trade pact will come when the terms become fair, equitable and balanced.

Negotiation for a trade agreement is a process and India has to secure the interests of its farmers, fishermen and small industry, Goyal said at the Indo-US Economic Summit, organised by the Indo-American Chamber of Commerce here.

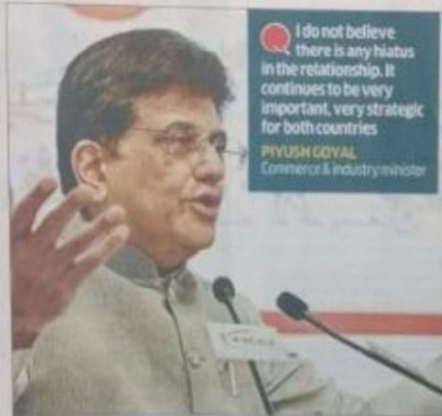
"We have to secure the interests of our stakeholders, businesses and balance it with our sensitivity to the farmers, with the fishermen, with small industries. When we find the right balance, rest assured we will get outcomes on this. When the deal will become fair, equitable and balanced, you will hear good news," Goyal said.

India and the US have been negotiating the proposed bilateral trade agreement since March, for six rounds of negotiations have been completed.

The minister said there is no cause for concern regarding the bilateral relationship, stressing that the two countries have a strong partnership rooted in democracy, diversity and a shared developmental vision.

"The US has hit India with 30% tariffs, including a 20% penalty for importing pharmaceuticals."

"Sometimes there is a bit of hick-up in the family," he said, adding, "I do not believe there is any hiatus in the relationship. It continues to be very, very important, very strategic for both countries."

## 'Jan Vishwas Bill 3.0 Ready to Boost Ease of Business'

New Delhi: The government is ready with the third edition of the Jan Vishwas Bill, aimed at deactivating various legal provisions to improve ease of doing business, Piyush Goyal said Tuesday.

The last iteration of the Jan Vishwas decriminalises 200 provisions to foster ease of doing business and all provisions to facilitate ease of living. "The government brought two editions of the Jan Vishwas Bill, and we have already passed the third version of the Jan Vishwas Bill to decriminalise all the provisions of law to make life easier for businesses and for the common man," he said, addressing a FICCI conference. He said he is meeting stakeholders, including representatives from e-commerce, startup and industry, to discuss ways to boost foreign direct investment (FDI) and foreign institutional investment (FII) by making the processes faster, simpler and more efficient.

Against the volatile and uncertain environment, India is an oasis in the desert and provides stability; an ecosystem of prosperity and growth, and unity in diversity, the minister said. "It is the politics of trust that is powering India towards becoming a developed nation," he added.

Urging industry leaders to be more ambitious, Goyal stressed the need for a more proactive approach to aid India's growth. "Set bold targets. We can't be satisfied with incremental growth, and we need to venture out of the ordinary. We need domestic capital in startups and R&D."

Highlighting five key expectations from industry bodies like FICCI to closely assist the results of their advocacy efforts and expand much India's remote regions.

"Industry bodies should not remain confined to elite business circles but must widen their engagement to support growth across the country," he added.

## India Inc should focus on augmenting local mfg: Goyal

**NEW DELHI:** Union commerce and industry minister Piyush Goyal on Tuesday asked India Inc to focus on four broad dimensions—augmenting domestic manufacturing, skilling youth, creating an investor-friendly ecosystem, and scouting for cutting edge technology—to achieve "Viksit Bharat" (developed India) goals by 2047.

Addressing the curtain raiser event of the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry's (FICCI) 98th annual general meeting and convention, he urged leaders to achieve self-reliance in goods that can be made in India competitively, and cautioned them about supply-chain vulnerabilities.

There could be some products where manufacturing might not immediately be competitive and in such cases, he said, it may be okay to get a few products from outside India until local manufacturing capacities are developed. "But this comes with a caveat," he said, urging them to assess their supply chains for vulnerabilities and advising

them not to be dependent on any one geography or one supplier.

"Is there a concentration of dependence which can hurt your production capabilities?" he asked, reminding them of the weaponisation of trade. "We really need to be extremely cautious and conscious," he added. For example, Goyal pointed at the pharma industry's vulnerabilities for import of active pharmaceutical ingredients (APIs).

Speaking about his second point, he said: "Can we look at converting the millennia children, the Amrit generation as we call them, all the kids born after 2000, into a skilled workforce, talented skilled workforce of consequences? There is a huge demand for good people," he

said, adding it could resolve the problem of under-employment.

"But, skilling them in the right direction, not just making everybody a job seeker," he stressed, citing an example of Germany where a skilled worker trained on the shopfloor of a plant gets a higher salary than possibly an engineer passing out from the college.

The third dimension that can help India become a developed nation by 2047 would be to create an investment-friendly ecosystem, which the Prime Minister always talks about while focusing on ease of doing business, the commerce minister said. "How can we remove the government out of your life... Reduce the compliance burden, decriminalise onerous laws, eliminate obsolete laws," Goyal said.

For that matter, today afternoon at three o'clock, I'm sitting down with stakeholders from the investment community to discuss what more we can do to make foreign direct investment (FDI) and foreign institutional investment (FII)... faster, smoother, more efficient," he added.

## Stronger energy relations set stage for trade pact with US

**THE SCALING UP** of liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) imports from the US is part of a plan to address Washington's concerns about the trade deficit with India, but the government is clear the much-trusted trade deal with that country will take place only if it is "fair."

India's home year LPG sourcing contract with the US announced on Monday is part of a long-term deal that is indicative of the progress in relations between the two sides, Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal said.

He said that the bilateral trade agreement (BTA) could be announced as soon as it becomes fair, balanced and equitable. "When the deal becomes fair, equitable, balanced you will hear good news soon," he said.

"Negotiations are a process and India as a nation has to secure its interests. Have to secure the interests of our stakeholders, businesses and balance it with our sensitivities. With the farmers, with the fishermen, with small industries, when we find the right balance, rest assured we will get outcomes on this score," the minister added.

"We just signed a major LPG agreement for importing over a long period of time every year 2.2 million tonnes per annum of LPG. So, it is an ongoing process. We both (India-US) are equally committed to expanding trade and commerce between the two countries," he said at the 22nd Indo-US Economic Summit organised by Commerce.

On Monday, Petroleum and Natural Gas Minister Hardeep Singh Puri had announced on X that Indian PSU oil companies have successfully concluded a 1-year deal for imports of around 2.2 MTPA (million tonnes per annum) LPG, close to

10% of our annual imports — for the contract year 2026, to be sourced from the US Gulf Coast — first structured contract of US LPG for the Indian market."

An official on Monday had termed the deal as part of India's endeavour to balance trade with the US. The trade balance in favour of India had brought in 25% reciprocal tariffs on India. The other 25% is for buying Russian oil.

Goyal sought to dispel the view that there has been a hiatus in the relationship between India and the US. He mentioned the LPG deal and the 30-year defence pact as examples of deep engagement between the sides despite additional tariffs. "Partnership that is as comprehensive as an India-US relationship with many elements, every element need not run at the same speed."

On Monday, an official had said that the first tranche of the BTA with the US that will address 50% additional tariffs on Indian products is more or less near closure and we should get it soon.

## Goyal holds discussions with key stakeholders on ways to promote FDI, FII

**COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY** Minister Piyush Goyal on Tuesday held a meeting with stakeholders to discuss ways to attract greater foreign investment in the country by streamlining the processes.

Representatives from sectors dealing with both foreign direct investment (FDI) and Foreign Institutional Investment (FII) were part of the meeting.

"The government is undertaking continuous consultations to further streamline FDI and FII processes to enable faster and more efficient investment flows into the country," the minister had said earlier at the Curtain Raiser of FICCI's 98th Annual General Meeting and Annual Convention.

## 'Good news on India-US trade pact once a fair deal is done'

Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal said there will be "good news" on the ongoing negotiations for the proposed India-US bilateral trade agreement (BTA) once the deal is "fair, equitable and balanced".

In the first tranche of the deal, India is focussed on a substantial rollback of the US' 50 per cent reciprocal and penal tariffs on Indian goods in exchange for which Washington seeks greater market access in a few specific sectors.

"Negotiation is a process. And India as a nation has to secure the interest of stakeholders, businesses and balance it with our sensitivities, with our farmers, with the fishermen, with the small industry. And when we find the right balance, you rest assured we will get outcomes," Goyal said, speaking at an event organised by the Indo-America Chamber of Commerce (IACC) on Tuesday. When the deal becomes fair, equitable and balanced, "you will hear the good news," he added.

New Delhi has already submitted its offers to Washington specifying the additional market access it was ready to grant to American

products in lieu of the rollback of the additional tariffs on Indian goods, but negotiations were on to refine the list further, a source tracking the matter told *businessline*.

The Minister said that there was no reason to be worried as there wasn't any hiatus in the relationship. "Pariwar mein kabhee kabhee thodee bohot nok-shok toh hotee rahatee hai (at times, there is a bit of bickering within the family)," he said, adding that the US-India relationship continued to be very important.

Elaborating on the major LPG agreement between the two countries, Goyal said that it was a pact to import over a long period of time, every year 2.2 million tonnes of LPG.

"As part of the BTA, the US has been interested in greater market access for both dairy and agricultural products, including items

such as soya and corn that are mostly of the GM variety in the country. It is difficult for India to give market access in these areas. But Delhi is willing to open up in other sectors where sensitivities are low. The deal will be struck once both sides agree on the package," the source said.

### RECIPROCAL TARIFF

India was hit with reciprocal tariffs of 25 per cent by the Trump administration on August 2, which was only slightly higher than the tariffs of 19-20 per cent on competing countries such as Vietnam, Bangladesh and Indonesia. However, on August 27, additional tariffs of 25 per cent were imposed on Indian goods as penalty for India's purchase of Russian oil, which increased the total tariffs to 50 per cent.

This rendered many labour-intensive exports from

India, including that of textiles, leather products, gems & jewellery, and engineering goods, uncompetitive in the American market.

"India wants to convince the US to bring down tariffs to levels below that of competing countries so that Indian exporters gain an edge in the American market," the source said.

Earlier this month, US President Donald Trump had said that tariffs were very high on India because of its Russian oil imports, but the US will be bringing the tariffs down as Delhi had substantially reduced its imports. When asked when would he bring down the tariffs, he said, "at some point of time".

White House economic adviser Kevin Hassett, too, said on Monday that the US was close to finalising a landmark trade agreement with India.

He added that trade talks with India had become complicated due to India's inter-actions with Russia.

Although India's oil purchase from Russia declined after the US imposed sanctions on Russian oil companies Rosneft and Lukoil last month, Delhi has no intention of agreeing to stop purchases from Moscow for both diplomatic and economic reasons.

## Stronger energy relations set stage for trade pact with US

THE SCALING UP of liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) imports from the US is part of a plan to address Washington's concerns about the trade deficit with India, but the government is clear the much-touted trade deal with that country will take place only if it is "fair."

India's one-year LPG sourcing contract with the US announced on Monday is part of a long-term deal that is indicative of the progress in relations between the two sides, Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal said.

He said that the bilateral trade agreement (BTA) could be announced as soon as it becomes fair, balanced and equitable. "When the deal becomes fair, equitable, balanced you will hear good news soon," he said.

"Negotiations are a process and India as a nation has to secure its interests. Have to secure the interests of our stakeholders, businesses and balance it with our sensitivities. With the farmers, with the fishermen, with small industries, when we find the right balance, rest assured we will get outcomes on this score," the minister added.

"We just signed a major LPG agreement for importing over a long period of time every year 2.2 million tonnes per annum of LPG. So, it is an ongoing process. We both (India-US) are equally committed to expanding trade and commerce between the two countries," he said at the 22nd Indo-US Economic Summit organised by Indo-American Chamber of Commerce.

On Monday, Petroleum and Natural Gas Minister Hardeep Singh Puri had announced on "X" that Indian PSU oil companies have successfully concluded a 1-year deal for imports of around 2.2 MTFA (million tonne per annum) LPG, close to

10% of our annual imports — for the contract year 2026, to be sourced from the US Gulf Coast — first structured contract of US LPG for the Indian market."

An official on Monday had termed the deal as part of India's endeavour to balance trade with the US. The trade balance in favour of India had brought in 25% reciprocal tariffs on India. The other 25% is for buying Russian oil.

Goyal sought to dispel the view that there has been a hiatus in the relationship between India and the US. He mentioned the LPG deal and the 10-year defence pact as examples of deep engagement between the sides despite additional tariffs. "Partnership that is as comprehensive as an India-US relationship with many elements, every element need not run at the same speed."

On Monday, an official had said that the first tranche of the BTA with the US that will address 50% additional tariffs on Indian products is more or less near closure and we should get it soon.

He added that India continues to outperform global growth projections and is likely to register higher exports of goods and services by the end of the financial year.

As per commerce ministry data, India's merchandise exports to US showed signs of recovery in October after four straight months of decline. Exports rose by \$6.3 billion in October, up 14.5% from September—the first month-on-month increase since May—despite Washington's 50% tariff on most Indian goods.

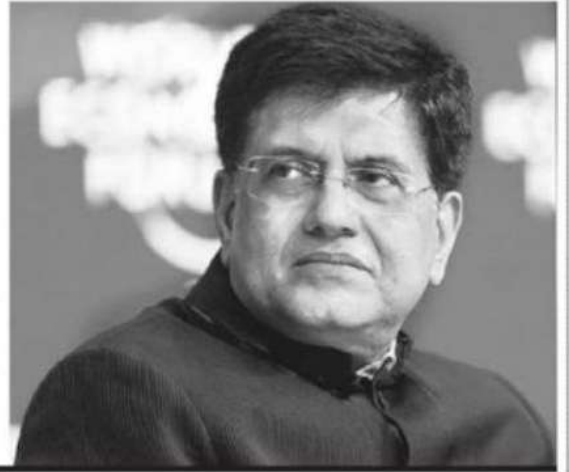
